Prime Area: Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term we will be; showing sensitivity to the feelings of others.

We are learning to; comfort our friends when they are upset. We will be inviting children who are alone to play with us. We will be careful with our words and will not say things that might upset our friends.

You can help your child by; encouraging them to play with a wide range of children outside school and praising them if they show care for other children.

Prime Area: Communication and Language

This term we will be; developing our ability to listen and concentrate.

We will be learning to; listen to stories without pictures or props.

You can help your child by; reading stories without pictures and talking about what has happened.

Reading

Our focus is to develop independence when reading.

We are all learning to read sentences without adult help.

We can use the tricky words we know and our sounds when we do this. This term we will be reading Pig in the Pond, the Scarecrow Wedding as well as books that the children show an interest in.

Please support your child in reading every day.

Writing

We will be retelling and re-writing stories. Our first text is Pig in the Pond. We will be writing instructions about how to grow things and animal facts. We will continue to use our sounds to write words and will be using capital letters and full stops in our sentences.

Maths

The focus of our maths will be counting in groups of 2, 5 and 10. We will continue to develop our understanding of number and adding and subtraction. When we read 'What the Ladybird Heard' we will be drawing maps and thinking about position.
