


LKS2 Newsletter – End of Term 2





P.E. this term will again be on **Mondays** and **Fridays** – although, please keep your PE kit in school throughout the week.

Home learning comes home on **Wednesday** and is due back on **Monday**.










During anti-bullying week, LKS2 became responsible adults. They worked in teams to use RESOLVE in order to overcome any problems.
