



Local History: My family, my life, our memories

	<p>Describe your family</p> <p>Draw or paint a picture of your family. Could you label your picture? For example, names, age or looks.</p> 	<p>Describe my life</p> <p>Order your family members by age.</p> <p>Who is the oldest? Who is the youngest?</p>	<p>My family history</p> <p>Ask your adult to find a picture of them on their first day at school.</p> <p>How were they feeling? Who was their teacher?</p>	<p>Significant events</p> <p>Choose an important event that has happened in your family. Ask your adult to show you some photos. Discuss when and why it happened and who was there.</p>	<p>Significant people</p> <p>Choose a family member who is significant to you. Can you make them a special card and write a sentence telling them why they are important.</p>

	<p>Challenge level 2</p> <p>Create a family tree. You can choose how to present it. For example, you could draw it, create it on the computer or make a 3D family tree using card.</p> 	<p>Create a timeline of your life so far. Include key events and when they happened e.g. when you were born, when you starting walking or when you started at Bowland Green etc.</p> 	<p>Choose a member of your family to interview about their time at school. Prepare some questions that you would like to ask.</p>  <p>After discuss the similarities and difference between their experience and yours.</p>	<p>Choose an important event that has happened in your lifetime. Tell us all about it! You could draw a picture showing this event, say when it happened and explain why it was so important.</p>	<p>Choose a family member who is significant to you. Can you create a fact file about them?</p>  <p>Include their name, age, where they were born, facts about their life and why they are significant.</p>

	<p>Challenge level 3</p> <p>Google your surname! Is there anyone famous with the same surname as you? Find out who they are and why they are famous.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Has a member of your family completed your family tree before? How far back have they managed to go? Find out as many facts as you can.</p>	<p>Create a scaled timeline of your life so far. You will need to show clear intervals between each stage and key information about different events.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=σ50HA6QTxj0 This link gives information on what to consider when creating a timeline.</p> 	<p>Choose someone in your family to find out more about! Perhaps you could call a relative or speak to someone in your household. Ask them questions about their life so you can create a timeline of their life so far including any key events.</p>	<p>Choose two important events that have happened in your lifetime. Create a mind map about each of them detailing what the event was, when it happened, why it happened, who was there etc....Compare both of the events. Which was most significant and why?</p> 	<p>Create a book about all of the people who are important to you. On each page, you could include facts about each person, explain who they are and why they are so important to you. This could be handwritten or typed 😊</p>
