What will happen next?

We are a **TEAM**. You will be listened to and your trusted adult will ask you questions to find out more. You must be **HONEST** so that they can help. We will record this information and share it with adults who need to know.

We will then **investigate** by speaking to people involved and work out a plan to help everyone. This plan will support you in feeling safe and give support to others involved too. Adults in school will check with you to see the plan is working, to ensure that everyone on our team is being safe, respectful and ready to learn.

Rude, Mean or Bullying?

When somebody says or does something that is unintentionally (by accident) harmful and they do it once, that's RUDE.

When someone says or does something intentionally (on purpose) hurtful and they do it once, or you do it back, they are being UNKIND and MEAN. Eg:

Isolating others from their friends
