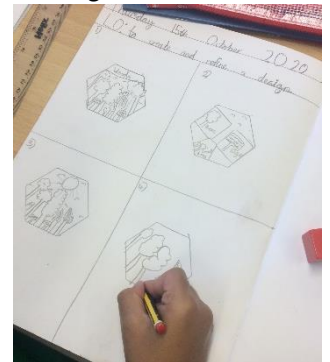




# LKS2 Newsletter

It will be getting colder so please ensure your children have the appropriate kit on.



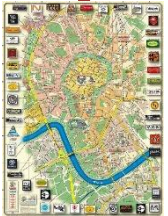
It is great to see so many children practising their times tables and spellings during the week.
