



Core Curriculum:

English Writing:

This term we will be reading the text 'The Rainbow Bear' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be developing our understanding and recall, as well as continuing to work on using the correct sentence structures, finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

You can help your child by:

- Practise letter formations and weekly spellings. You can practise in lots of fun ways such as painting the words or writing with chalk outside.
- Provide lots of opportunities to write for example: writing a shopping list.

English Reading:

This term we will be... continuing to learn our Set 2 and 3 sounds through our Speed Sound and Story book sessions. The sounds taught will depend on the group your child is in.

You can help your child by:

- Listen to your child read their Ditty book and colour banded book at least 5 times a week.
- Read to your child daily. Use the top ten tips for parents provided in your child's reading log.
- Encouraging your child to 'teach' you how to read.

English Spelling/Phonics:

We will continue to work in our phonics groups to cover all our sounds and spelling patterns through ReadWriteInc.

Maths:

This term we will be learning:

Place Value within 20: We will be learning to understand place value through exploring numbers to twenty and understanding the concept of tens and ones

Addition and Subtraction within 20: we will be continuing to apply our knowledge of addition and subtraction focusing on addition and subtraction symbols and using two digit numbers within 20.

You can help your child by:

- Counting to 20 and back from 20
- Practising to add and subtract numbers within 20.
- Ask your child simple addition and subtraction number sentences

Mathematical Fluency:

This term we will be continuing to practise our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. You can help your child by chanting the 2, 5 or 10 times tables. Listening to songs about the 2, 5 or 10 times table. Practising writing number sentences for the 2, 5 or 10 times table.

Science:


This term our unit is all about Materials. We will be learning all about different materials. We will be learning to identify and classify a range of different materials.

Cycle 1: SPRING TERM 3

Art and Design:

We will be developing our knowledge of primary colours and using them in our own work.

We will be inspired by the artist Piet Mondrian to create our own art.



Be Safe:

We will be learning about the impact that global warming has on our environment and what we can do to help.

Project outcome:

History:

This term is a geography topic, but we will use this information about the place to explore what it was like in the past in later units.

Design and Technology:

In DT, we will be learning about cooking and nutrition. We will discuss a balanced diet and create some mini pizzas! We will also revisit our skills of designing and evaluating our product.

Next term will be R.E.

Computing:

Our unit this term is called Online Safety. We will be learning how to stay safe online and what to do if we come across something unsafe.

Geography:

In Geography, we will be learning all about the Polar Regions. We will be considering the land forms in the Polar Regions and how this differs to the UK. We will also be exploring the weather; locally, nationally and globally. Alongside the weather, we will be thinking about the climate zones of different parts of our world. We will be thinking about the impact of Climate Change and how we effect this and what we can do to help.



Music:

In music, we use the Charanga Music programme. Our unit this term is called 'I wanna play in a band!' This unit focuses on interrelated dimensions of music e.g. pulse, rhythm, pitch etc.

Next term will be Spanish.
