Here is a list of the spellings that will be taught over the next term.

You can practise these at home by using look, say, cover, write, check; by testing them, and by using Spelling Shed.

<p><u>Week One</u></p> <p>The /l/ sound spelled '-le' at the end of words.</p>	<p><u>Week Two</u></p> <p>Adding the suffix '-ly' when the root word ends in '-le' then the '-le' is changed to '-ly.'</p>	<p><u>Week Three</u></p> <p>Adding the suffix '-ally' which is used instead of '-ly' when the root word ends in '-ic.'</p>
<p><u>Week Four</u></p> <p>Adding the suffix -ly. Words that do not follow the rules.</p>	<p><u>Week Five</u></p> <p>Challenge words.</p>	<p><u>Week Six</u></p> <p>Words ending in '-er' when the root word ends in (t)ch.</p>
